PADDLING GUIDELINES

— Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill —

Shaker Landing is one of the premier launch sites on the Kentucky River. Situated in the scenic Kentucky River Palisades, along a stretch of river with high limestone cliffs and untouched natural beauty, Shaker Landing affords paddlers an unprecedented view of the oldest exposed rock in Kentucky, as well as High Bridge, an engineering marvel built in 1877. Your support and launch fees enable Shaker Village to continuously maintain and improve Shaker Landing and your paddling experience. Please follow these guidelines during your visit.

DAILY REGISTRATION IS REQUIRED. Paddlers must register in the Trustees' Office.

DAILY LAUNCH FEE \$5 per vessel

REGISTRATION PROCESS

- 1. Pay launch fee, and complete a health and safety waiver in the Trustees' Office.
- 2. Check out the gate key for River Road from the Trustees' Office. You will be asked to leave a form of identification in exchange for the key. When you return the key, you will be given back your card.
- 3. Place Shaker Landing Pass on the driver's side dashboard of your vehicle.

LAUNCH REGULATIONS

- All paddlers must register, complete a health and safety waiver, and pay appropriate daily launch fees.
- Launching is only permitted for non-motorized vessels, such as canoes, kayaks and stand up paddleboards.
- Paddling Pass must be visible on the driver's side dashboard of your vehicle.
- Please secure your belongings in vehicles parked at Shaker Landing. Shaker Village is not responsible for theft
 or damage.
- When the Dixie Belle is not running due to weather or river conditions, there is no launching.
- River Road is one way for traffic, and during certain hours, traffic may be restricted due to the operations of the *Dixie Belle* Riverboat.
- There is a dam located approximately 1 mile south of Shaker Landing, within view of the launch. Please use caution and avoid the dam.
- There is a portable restroom facility at Shaker Landing, but no other facilities.
- No trash receptacles are available at Shaker Landing. Please remove your trash.
- Picnics are permitted at Shaker Landing.
- Dogs on leashes are permitted at Shaker Landing.
- Overnight parking is not permitted.
