## HOURS + PRICES

Shaker Village is in the Eastern Time Zone, and Daylight Savings Time is in effect. Reservations must be made in advance to receive discounted prices. Students (under 18) include schools, home school groups and other youth groups. Groups are defined as 20+ students with at least one teacher or adult chaperone. Activity times are flexible. We are happy to design a schedule to fit your needs!

## DIXIE BELLE

RIVERBOAT RIDES.......\$5 per person Enjoy a relaxing ride aboard Shaker Village's 115-passenger riverboat, through high limestone cliffs and untouched natural beauty. One-hour narrated cruises describe the historical importance of the river to the Shakers and pass under High Bridge, an engineering marvel built in 1877. (available seasonally)

#### Tues-Sun 2PM + 4PM

Sack lunches may be eaten on board during your ride.

In the event of high water levels or inclement weather, rides may be canceled for your safety. A "Make-and-Take" will be substituted as an activity. Please allow 15 minutes travel time to Shaker Landing, located 1.5 miles from the Village. River Road is somewhat narrow, and during peak usage, one-way traffic patterns are maintained.

**PRESERVE HIKE**...... *\$5 per person* See Shaker Village from the same vista as Shaker hunters and Kentucky pioneers. This active hike will engage students with restored native grassland and wildlife on our trails and historic sites just beyond The Historic Centre.



## **DINE** The Trustees' Table

Dine on traditional favorites and seasonal Kentucky dishes prepared with straight-from-the-garden ingredients. #### **MEAL GUARANTEES**

Confirmation of attendance for either meal function is required 48 hours in advance. Sunday, Monday and Tuesday confirmation must be received by noon the preceding Friday. This number will be considered a guarantee and is not subject to reduction. If no guarantee is received, the original number on the confirmation agreement will be your guaranteed number, and you will be charged for that number. An increase in number will be allowed based on availability.

- Please alert us to any food allergies or dietary needs when making your reservation. Meals are prepared on shared equipment with milk, egg, peanut, tree nut, wheat, soybean, fish or shellfish.
- Advance registration is required.
- Teachers/chaperones must be included in registration and will receive the student meal option.

A 18 percent service charge and 6 percent Kentucky sales tax (unless your school's tax exemption certificate is on file) is added to the price of all meals served at The Trustees' Table and sack lunches. 

Shaker Village is a 3,000-acre property, and historic buildings are spread throughout the grounds. The terrain is often rough, and the Village has many uneven limestone sidewalks and gravel paths. All of the restored 19th century buildings have two or more steps, and no elevators are available.
