## Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill

This checklist includes more than 150 species of birds presently known to have occurred inside the boundaries of Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill and along the Kentucky River Gorge.

Shaker Village's 3,000 acres offers a variety of birding opportunities, from open grasslands which cover large areas, to savanna zones and forests, to ponds and streams which are wet or dry depending on the season. These diverse habitats attract an assortment of bird species throughout the year. Please note that some migrants might be present for only two weeks or so.
