

## 9-12 Grade Student Experiences The Preserve

- The suggested timeframe for each program is one hour.
- Fees: \$8 per student/chaperone for 1st program, \$5 per student/chaperone for each additional program.
- School staff are free of charge.
- The minimum adult to student ratio is 2:25 | maximum adult to student ratio is 5:25.

**Shaker Footprints: The Lost Village** – Walk in the footprints of the Shakers and discover what history is hidden in plain sight! We'll learn how to "read" Pleasant Hill's natural and archaeological landscape, and in the process, learn to understand the processes that continually shape our world.
