

TRAIL REGULATIONS

Shaker Village of Pleasant Hill

- All trail users must register and pay appropriate daily usage fees at the front entrance.
- Trails are open from dawn until dusk. (6:00 am - 8:30 pm in summer)
- No motorized vehicles are allowed off paved roadways.
- No restroom facilities, drinking water or trash receptacles are available on the trails. Portable restroom facilities are located next to The Stable.
- Trails travel through protected areas. Do not disturb or collect plants, animals, rocks, fossils or remains of human history. Please enter creeks only in designated crossing areas.
- Shed hunting is prohibited.
- Trails pass abandoned mine sites. Do not enter mine sites.
- Parts of Towering Sycamore Trail, Pelly Trail and Tanyard Trail are seasonal and may be impassable due to high water.
- Dogs are only permitted on Village Loop, River Road Trail and Palisades Trail.
- Horse trailers must park in the designated area behind The Stable.
- Shaker Village does not provide horses for trail riding.
- Hikers and cyclists yield to equestrians on trails.
- Hunting on Shaker Village property is prohibited.
- Currently, no fishing is available onsite except at the pond near the Welcome Center, with paid admission and a valid fishing license. Fishing is catch and release only.
- If you pack it in, pack it out. Please practice Leave No Trace.
